

# Jarrett Moehn earns Eagle Scout honor

Jarrett Moehn of Richmond has earned the highest rank awarded by the Boy Scouts of America — Eagle Scout.

Since it was introduced in 1911, more than two million men have earned the Eagle Scout rank, a lifelong title.

After hours upon hours of devotion to his community, Moehn, a Calvary Episcopal College Prep School senior, has joined that class of men.

He is the son of Larry and Pat Moehn of Richmond.

As part of his requirements to earn the Eagle rank, Moehn had to earn 21 merit badges and complete a service project that he had to plan and manage.

Moehn's project focused on the nonprofit organization AnySoldier.com, founded by Marty Horn.

AnySoldier.com is a family-run organization that encourages the community to support for the military troops, active duty and reservists, through letters and care packages.

Moehn teamed with Horn to create a plan that would support a Marine squadron.

For more than four months, and hours a day, he wrote letters, made speeches, and coordinated the needs of the squadron. With his guidance and the help of his troop family and friends Moehn exceeded his goal and was also even able to support a second squadron for the organization.

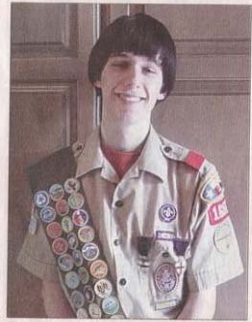
Besides his Eagle project, Moehn is known for his hours of community support. His volunteering record includes: The Angle Food Project, Adopt A Highway trash cleanup, the George Ranch Historical park, community Easter egg hunts, hurricane food drives, Beacon Ministry and the Pecan Grove Volunteer Fire department fundraiser, "Five Miles My Way."

He currently has 42 merit badges and earned his St. Paul Religious Medal and the Conservation Award.

On the road to honor  
Long before he was an Eagle, though, Moehn was a Bear, the rank he held in second grade with Pack 1880.

He went on to earn his Cub Scout Arrow of Light, which is the Cub Scouts highest honor, before he joined Troop 1656.

Over his years of service, Moehn earned the ranks of Scout, Tenderfoot, Second Class, First Class, Star, Life, before earning Eagle.
